Flooding on Calusa Trace Blvd.

Flooding was reported on Calusa Trace Blvd. on Monday, March 12th after a storm passed through Calusa Trace. The section manager for County stormwater Engineering Services has been notified and sent pictures of the area flooded. The area was south of Pine Isle and on both sides of the Blvd. According to Engineering services, this may take up to 45 days to investigate due to backlog from the hurricanes.

Calusa Trace Blvd – Sewer line project

Most of the sewer line construction has been completed on Calusa Trace Blvd. There are still some loose ends to finish. The county has agreed to replace the sod with St. Augustine, and they are also responsible for replacing the irrigation. A proposal for the irrigation repairs has been provided to the county by Red Tree. As you may have noticed, work is about to begin on Van Dyke. This construction will include a sewer line from the Van Dyke lift station all the way to Dale Mabry. The traffic pattern has changed in that the right turn lanes are now shut down when heading west on Van Dyke. Please drive with caution when using the Van Dyke entrance.





Not all mosquitoes are the same. Different mosquitoes spread different diseases and bite at different times of the day. Some mosquito species bite during the day, such as those mosquitoes that can spread chikungunya, dengue and Zika viruses. Other species of mosquitoes bite most often at dawn and dusk, including those that can transmit West Nile virus.

Mosquitoes can live indoors and will bite at any time, day or night.

I. CALL TO ORDER

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – 2 min (December 10, 2024 and January 14, 2025)

David Jacobs made a motion to approve the December 10, 2024 Board of Directors meeting minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by Bob Weinstock. All in favor, motion passed.

Bob Weinstock made a motion to approve the January 14, 2025 Board of Directors meeting minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by David Jacobs. **All in favor, motion passed.**

IV. REPORTS

a. President

Bob Weinstock made a motion to authorize Samantha Morfa to notify the Greenacre Accounts Receivable team to hold collections and Notices of Late Assessment (NOLAs) for those owners who have paid at least 50% of their 2025 assessment, and to waive any penalties and interest that have already been applied to these accounts, on the understanding that the Association typically runs on a bi-annual assessment schedule but has recently updated their policy to an annual assessment schedule effective 2025. The motion was seconded by Frank Julian. All in favor, motion passed. Sam Morfa will provide the Board with an updated aging status for the March meeting to review any remaining outstanding accounts.

Bob Weinstock asked Cherice Greco to run a redaction in the next Tracer regarding member names as discussed, and to move the business meeting minutes to the end of the newsletter for ease of access moving forward.

b. Treasurer

Frank Julian provided an overview of the Financial Statements for period ending 1/31/25; there are no issues to report in this period.

A. Architectural Report - Approved Applications - 5 min

Sherwin Williams will be uploading paint schemes within the next few days, and notification will be sent to owners when schemes become available for viewing / use. A brief discussion was held on window variance requests / possible guideline updates (disc. only; no motions).

A. Tracer - Deadline

Samantha Morfa reminded everyone that the deadline for Tracer submissions are due to Cherice Greco by the 20th of the month.

VII. OLD BUSINESS

A. Pond Report – 2 min

Samantha Morfa discussed the pond report and noted that there are no obvious issues at this time.

B. Natural Disaster / Hurricane Fund

Samantha Morfa noted that the Association legal counsel has recommended the Board work to create an Operating account Natural Disaster / Hurricane fund for future needs in lieu of using Reserve funds. The Board will reevaluate this item during budget review.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS

A. RedTree Proposal - Ratify Tree Work

Bob Weinstock made a motion to ratify the Redtree Landscape proposal dated 1/15/25 in the amount of \$1,800.00 for dead oak removal at the Dale Mabry entrance. The motion was seconded by Frank Julian. **All in favor, motion passed.**

B. Tigris Aquatic Services

Bob Weinstock made a motion to approve Tigris Aquatic Services quote 268637 dated 1/27/25 in the annual amount of \$22,776.00 for monthly pond maintenance services (\$1,898.00 per month). The motion was seconded by Cherice Greco. **All in favor, motion passed.**

C. Community Event at Park

Discussion was held on an event for the fall, with a questionnaire / survey being added to the Tracer to gauge member interest.

IX. HOMEOWNER COMMENTS – 3 min each

Items brought forth by the membership included:

- Fireworks nuisance Gregory Wilson CAM can send nuisance violations if this is a recurring issue
- No Fishing / No Trespassing signs Gregory Wilson signs will be installed and membership is reminded they can call Sheriff's
 office non-emergency line if issue persists


