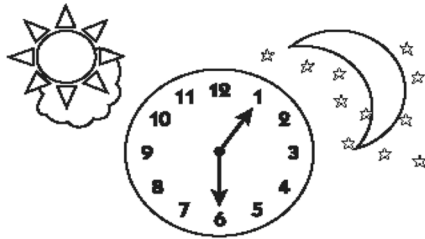

Weathering the Storm

I'm not sure if I'm alone in this, but this month, I'm always holding my breath in anticipation of a hurricane. It's wild how incredible our brains are - creating anxiety over something that hasn't even occurred yet.

Our brains know from experience that storms are a threat and that we should fear them. In that sense, anxiety is meant to keep us vigilant so that when the storm finally comes, we're prepared.

But what do we do when the storm finally arrives? Prep or no prep, what helps us weather those moments the best we can?

Of course, I'm using the storm as a symbol for anxiety, stress, and grief. But that's what they can feel like for us-storms. Worrying times that we anticipate, prepare for, and ultimately have to find our way through.

We may not be able to stop the storm from coming, but we can find ways to give ourselves a little shelter while we're in it. So, what can help us stay grounded when everything around- or within- us feels unsettled?

Ironically, in this narrative, nature itself can help us reconnect with the present moment. Interacting with nature can be incredibly beneficial for our nervous system. It doesn't have to be much-even taking 10 to 15 minutes a day to stand in the grass, go for a walk, watch the trees sway, notice the squirrels running around, tend to a bird feeder, or simply take a moment to soak in the awe of what's around us can make a difference.

Setting boundaries-not just with others, but with ourselves-is another way we can care for our nervous system. This means setting limits around the things we might even love but that can consume a lot of our time, energy, and attention. This can include work, social media, and sometimes even social interactions.

It's about noticing how our body responds, recognizing when we've reached our limit, and giving ourselves permission to hit pause. Taking the necessary time away allows us to regulate, reconnect with ourselves, or simply engage in something that more closely supports our parasympathetic nervous system and gives our mind and body a chance to slow down.

And finally, there's no need to fix anything. Giving yourself the opportunity to simply be with what you're feeling or thinking, rather than avoiding it or pushing it away, gives your body the space to process what you're experiencing and release some of the physical tension that comes with it. Be mindful of how you talk to yourself about these feelings and try your best not to judge them. Speak to yourself as you would if a friend were sitting in front of you, sharing the same thoughts and emotions. We can't always control when the storms come or how intense they'll be. Sometimes, all we can do is learn how to weather them-grounding ourselves in the present, honoring our limits, and allowing ourselves to feel what needs to be felt.

I hope this hurricane season is a quiet one-both literally and figuratively.
